<p>Values</p> <p>Our values for this term are FORGIVENESS and COMPASSION. Choose one and create a poster, a picture or a story to show why this value is important at home and at school.</p>	<p>Music</p> <p>Learn to sing the alphabet song. Be careful to sing the letters; L, M, N, O P carefully, so that you can hear each letter.</p> <p>Learn to sing some Nursery Rhymes you did not know before.</p>	<p>Geography</p> <p>Draw a map of a place that you know well and write some labels for it. It could be of your garden, a room in your house, your hamster's cage, a park you like or a plan for how your toys should sit on your windowsill!</p>	<p>Science</p> <p>Go on a 'MATERIALS' hunt around your house.</p> <p>Make a list of all the different materials you can find. Draw some pictures or take some photographs of the materials.</p>
<p>PE</p> <p>Make an obstacle course in your garden. Try and include something to balance on, something to crawl under, something to run around. Time your family trying it out. Who is the quickest?</p>	<p>RE</p> <p>Learn the Christmas story. Make a picture or pictures of the story and use it/ them to tell the story to someone else.</p>	<p>Writing</p> <p>Create a piece of writing which involves machines. It could be information about how something works, like a bike, or it could be a story about an imaginary machine- it's up to you!</p>	<p>Reading</p> <p>Read your book 5 times a week so your reading improves. Remember to also share more difficult books where an adult reads to you and you discuss and enjoy the book together.</p> <p>Play PHONICS games.</p>
<p>Design Technology</p> <p>Design or design and make your own machine. It could be your own version of a machine that already exists, or could be a completely new invention!</p>	<p>Maths</p> <p>Find creative ways to learn the numerals and words to 20, with correct spellings e.g. label each step on the stairs. Count in 2's by pairing your shoes and socks and writing word labels for them.</p>	<p>History</p> <p>Interview your grandparent or an older friend to ask them about what it was like growing up in the past.</p> <p>What is the same? What is different?</p> <p>Which time would you prefer?</p>	<p>Art</p> <p>Create a piece of art that shows your drawing skills. You can choose what you draw e.g. patterns and shapes, a copy of something real, your pet, or you could experiment with different drawing materials.</p>
