<p><i>Values</i></p> <p>Find out what our Value is for this half term. Create a poster to show why this value is important at home and in school.</p>	<p><i>Writing</i></p> <p>Write a story of your choice. Remember to use full stops, capitals to start sentences and for names, finger spaces and adjectives to describe.</p>	<p><i>Geography</i></p> <p>Look at a map to find where the seven continents and five oceans are. Can you learn a song to help you remember them? (see YouTube)</p>	<p><i>Music</i></p> <p>Make an instrument e.g. an elastic band guitar, water filled jars, drums, a shaker. How can you change the sound that your instrument makes? Can you make it louder or quieter/ higher or lower pitched?</p>
<p><i>PE</i></p> <p>Walk about a mile a day, for at least a week. This can include your walk to school and back. Keep a simple diary of where you walked.</p>	<p><i>RE Easter</i></p> <p>Learn the Easter story and present it in a way of your choice. (You could draw a picture of the story, video yourself telling part of it, make a book or any other way.)</p>	<p><i>Science</i></p> <p>Find out about an animal. This could be a pet or a wild animal. Find out where it likes to live and what it eats. Draw a picture of the animal in its home/ habitat. Tell us some facts about it.</p>	<p><i>Reading</i></p> <p>Read your book 5 times a week. Practice your phonics at home by using the phonics sheets. Write a book review of a book you have read. What did you like about it? Which was your favourite character and why?</p>
<p><i>Design Technology</i></p> <p>Design and make a toy or product using felt or fabric. If you have help, you could sew it, but if not, you could glue or staple it together.</p>	<p><i>Maths</i></p> <p>Play games of snakes and ladders, or bingo to practice recognising, reading and counting on using numbers to 100.</p>	<p><i>History</i></p> <p>Talk to an older member of your family about the toys they had when they were young. Do they still have any that they could show you? Take photographs, draw pictures or write about what you found out.</p>	<p><i>Art</i></p> <p>Produce a piece of art inspired by our theme of adventure (including under the sea). This can be a painting, a model, a collage or any medium you find interesting.</p>
