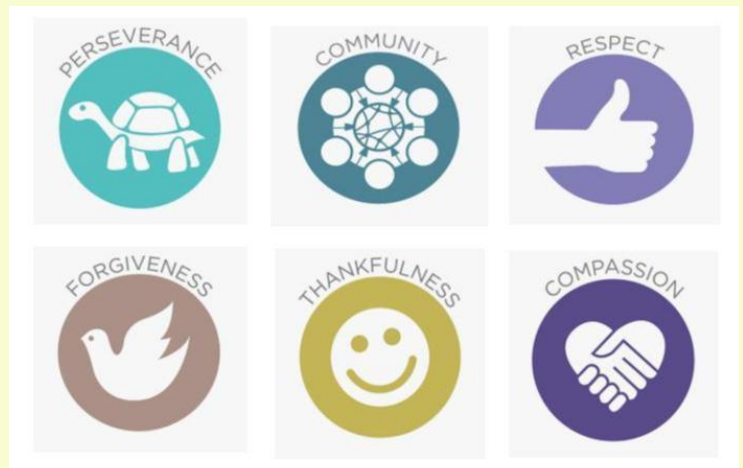


### Vision and Values Day


As part of this project, we will be running a Parkrun taster event on Friday 14<sup>th</sup> November
