### Book Fair at Parents' Evening


We are really pleased to be holding our Book Fair on Thursday 12th February (3:15pm-5.30pm) to coincide with Parents' Evening again this year.

The Fair is being run with our local Usborne Partner, Rosie's Book Store. Usborne will donate up to 60% of the total Book Fair sales value raised so for every £10 of books purchased, we will get £6 in free Usborne books for our school libraries.

Each class will have a chance to browse the books during the school day and children will create their own 'Wish List'. The Fair will then be open at the end of school until 5.30pm, so you are free to order books after school as well as before and after your appointment with your child's teacher.

Books can be purchased via card, contactless or cash payments, and you will receive your order within 2 weeks. Children will not be able to buy books themselves using cash so there is no need for them to bring money. If you are unable to make it on Thursday 12th February, you will be able to order directly, using your child's Wish List for guidance.
