

Vocabulary	
fertilisation	The process of the male and female sex cells fusing together.
gestation	The process or time when prenatal development takes place before birth.
puberty	The physical stage of development between childhood and adulthood.
menstruation	When the female body discharges the lining of the uterus. This happens approximately once a month.
infancy	The period of life between birth and the acquisition of language approximately one to two years later.
chromosomes	A structure found inside the nucleus of a cell.
embryo	The early stage of development of a multicellular organism.
uterus	A muscular organ of the female reproductive system.
ovary	One of a pair of female glands in which the eggs form and the female hormones oestrogen and progesterone are made.
placenta	The sac-shaped organ that attaches the embryo or foetus to the uterus during pregnancy in most mammals.

Human life cycle	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Foetus - at this time, a baby is growing inside his/her mum's womb. 2. Baby - born after spending 9 months inside the womb. 3. Childhood - at this stage, you learn many skills including walking and talking. 4. Adolescence - children become teenagers. 5. Adulthood - body is fully developed. 6. Old age - the last stage in the life cycle of a human.
Puberty	Puberty is a process that normally occurs in a girl between 10 and 14. Boys typically go through puberty between the ages of 12 and 16. However, this is not necessarily always the case as everyone is individual and will go through this process at their own rate.
