

Autumn Term Curriculum Newsletter - Year 6

English

Writing Create effective narratives through the study of our class text, *Street Child*. Make links with our wider curriculum to produce non-fiction texts which are effective at explaining, persuading and discussing. Continue to understand the writing process through proofreading and editing.

Reading Continue to develop effective decoding and comprehension skills through class texts and focussed reading lessons.

Grammar Continue to learn how to apply a range of grammatical conventions, including developing a wider range of punctuation.

Handwriting develop a neat, joined script which is applied across the curriculum.

Place value: working with large numbers, understanding their value; rounding; calculating with negative numbers.

The four operations of addition, subtraction, multiplication and division: written and mental methods of calculation explored and secured with both whole and decimal numbers.

Fractions: understanding equivalent fractions, improper fractions and mixed number fractions, calculating with each applying the four operations.

Daily arithmetic will build the children's strategies and resilience to calculate accurately and time-effectively.
