

Summer Term Curriculum Newsletter Year 6

English

Writing Create effective narratives through the study of our class texts.

Make links with our wider curriculum to produce non-fiction texts which are effective at informing and persuading.

Continue to understand the writing process through proofreading and editing.

Reading Continue to develop effective decoding and comprehension skills through class texts and focussed reading lessons.

Grammar Continue to learn how to apply a range of grammatical conventions, including developing a wider range of punctuation.

Handwriting develop a neat, joined script which is applied across the curriculum.

Maths

Place value: working with large numbers, understanding their value.

The Four operations of addition, subtraction, multiplication and division: written and mental methods of calculation explored and secured with both whole and decimals numbers.

Properties of shape / geometry: understanding properties of 2-dimensional and 3-dimensional shapes, applying these to our calculations.

Examination of angles in shapes, using their names and properties when calculating. **Position and Direction:** reflection, translation and rotation in quadrants

Daily arithmetic (Maths on Track) will build the children's strategies and resilience to calculate accurately and time-effectively.
