

<p><b>Values</b></p> <p>Our values for this half term are 'perseverance' (before half term) and 'respect' (after half term).</p> <p>Create a poster to show why this value is important at home and in school for our Worship display.</p>	<p><b>Geography</b></p> <p>Find a blank world map and label 5-7 major deserts.</p> <p>Next to each, note: continent/country, type (hot or cold), average rainfall (under 250mm/year), and one adaptation (e.g., camels store fat in humps for hot deserts; polar bears have thick fur for cold ones).</p>	<p><b>History</b></p> <p>Research Athens (democracy, philosophy, arts) and Sparta (military training, equality for women, warrior culture).</p> <p>Create a comparison table or Venn diagram showing similarities (e.g., both polytheistic, city-states) and differences (e.g., Athens valued debate; Sparta valued strength).</p>	<p><b>Writing</b></p> <p>Design your own escape room puzzle: Describe the setting (sights, sounds, smells), clues (riddles, codes), and dangers using expanded noun phrases and adverbs (e.g., "shadowy corridors loomed menacingly").</p>
<p><b>PE</b></p> <p>Play 3 short rallies (to 5 points) focusing on ready position (knees bent, feet apart) and moving to the ball.</p> <p>Film or take photos of this and note what went well and what needs improving.</p>	<p><b>RE</b></p> <p>Choose 3 modern scenarios, e.g.: a playground bully, sharing toys unfairly, helping a homeless person.</p> <p>Create a comic strip or poster showing the dilemma, Jesus' response, and your action plan.</p>	<p><b>Music</b></p> <p>Listen to 3 Motown tracks: "My Girl" (Temptations), "Dancing in the Street" (Martha and the Vandellas), "Uptight" (Stevie Wonder).</p> <p>Create a 1-minute performance: Lip-sync one song and clap rhythms.</p>	<p><b>Science</b></p> <p>Gather 6-8 household items. Test properties: hardness, transparency, solubility, conductivity, magnetism and flexibility.</p>
<p><b>Design and Technology</b></p> <p>Research a simple recipe. Check Eatwell Guide: Ensure 1/3 fruit/veg, 1/3 carbs, some protein/dairy; note calories per portion.</p> <p>Create a labelled poster with ingredients list and nutrition facts.</p>	<p><b>French</b></p> <p>Draw a labelled poster featuring eight habitats with two animals per habitat.</p> <p>Include a brief description of one animal's daily routine.</p>	<p><b>P.S.H.E.</b></p> <p>Design a poster with drawings/photos based on personal strengths and areas you would like to develop. Include a "success treasure chest" for achievements, affirmations like "I try my best", and family input on your qualities.</p>	<p><b>Art and Design</b></p> <p>Sketch your face using a mirror: Measure proportions (head = 5 eyes wide; eyes halfway down head; nose to chin = 3 noses long).</p> <p>Add details: Hairline, ears (top to bottom align with eyes), expression showing personality (e.g., smile lines).</p>
