### Year 4 MTC

All children need to be fluent in their times tables, especially for the Year 4 MTC check and the Year 6 SATs, so please do prioritise practising these at home.

### Year 1 Phonics Checks

Next week, children in Year 1 will be completing their phonics checks. This will involve Mrs Bill working with the children 1:1 and reading real and alien words aloud using their known phonics. Please do ensure that your children practise reading real and alien words eg. 'Church' and 'choat' in the run up to this.

Our wonderful Year 6s have been inspired to run another cake sale, in order to raise funds for new calm corners in each classroom. They will be running the cake sale after school on Thursday 11<sup>th</sup> June and all cakes will be 50p or £1
