We are also thrilled to introduce Forest School for Years 1–6, which will take place on Monday afternoons and be led by Mrs Turnbull, our qualified Level 3 Forest School Leader. Each year group will enjoy a half-term block of Forest School during the year, with Year 1 being the first class to take part from September.

Forest School provides children with exciting opportunities to develop confidence, resilience and independence through hands-on experiences such as den building, safe tool use, whittling, fire lighting, nature exploration and problem-solving.
