


**Online Safety and Acceptable Use Agreements** Our children are growing up in a world of ever-changing technology. Although technology can play a very positive role in our children's lives and education, we cannot ignore the risks, which can also be associated with the increasing amount of time spent online.

At school, we take our safeguarding responsibilities very seriously, this extends to making sure children, and families know how to stay safe online. We teach the children to always speak to an adult if they see something worrying or upsetting online and how to navigate cyber-bullying and use the internet responsibly.

As part of this process your child will be asked to sign an annual Acceptable Use Agreement to demonstrate that they understand the expectations around the use of technology in school. This has been sent to you as a Google Form. Please complete this with your child so that they can access the school equipment and work online. Year R parents will also need to complete a separate agreement themselves.
