



Road Safety Talks

At Powick we know it is particularly important that our children understand how to keep safe on the roads as many of our families walk, cycle and scoot to school along the busy main road. This week all of the classes took part in Road Safety talks which helped them understand the risks and how to keep themselves safe around roads and vehicles.



The children talked about where and when it is safe to cross and that younger children should always hold an adult's hand. They were reminded to **Stop, Look, Listen and Think** if it is safe to cross before stepping out into a road or across a driveway.

Then on Friday the Reception children took part in Balance Bike training. They took turns to have sessions in the tennis court practicing their balance and listening skills.

All of the Reception children took part with brilliant enthusiasm and listening and really enjoyed playing games with the instructors. Well done Year R!

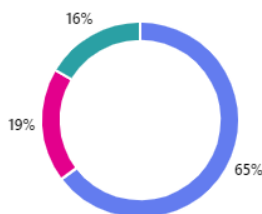
