



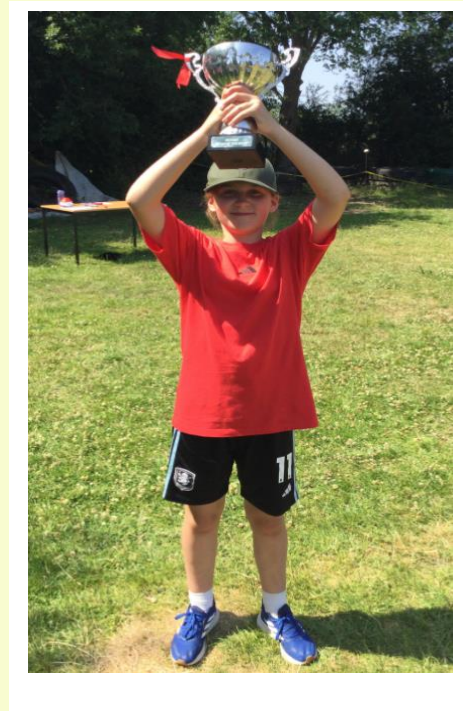
Sports Day
