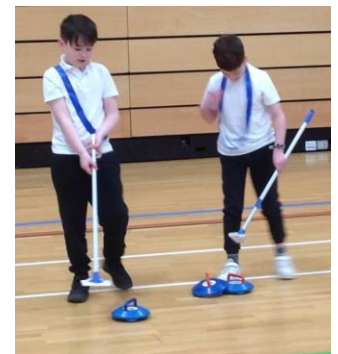




Year 3 and 4 Inter house Games at Worcester University –


