Pupil Parliament Report on this terms project s Evaluating Attendance at After School Clubs.

Pupil Parliament asked every year group except Reception class to complete a survey about the clubs offered at Powick Primary School. We shared the results at an assembly led by Pupil Parliament and this article will tell you why we needed this information and who we asked.

Who we asked At lunchtime Pupil Parliament went round the playground and asked many children from different year groups for their opinions. The children answered many different types of questions depending on whether they were in KS1 or KS2. For example, if they were in KS2 they would have to answer more in-depth questions than if they were in KS1. **Why we asked** In school we wanted to know how to improve and one of these choices is clubs and this is why. For example, one of the reasons is that students have a wider range of clubs for enjoyment.

What we found out We found out that a lot of pupils attend after school clubs friends attend that club and because it is good for their mental and physical health. Additionally, we found out that the majority would like after school board games and mindfulness clubs added on to the timetable.

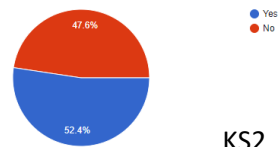

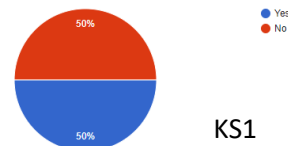


Do you go to any after school clubs run by school?
