Year 6 – 92.6%

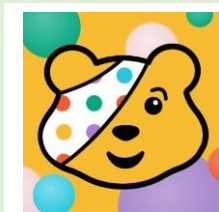


